**Rules and Regulations**

**DIRECTOR / CHAIRMAN**

(WHEREVER THE TERM TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR/CHAIRMAN IS USED, IT SHALL ALSO BE INTERPRETED TO MEAN, IN THEIR ABSENCE, A DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE.)

**1. GENERAL**

The Tournament Director / Chairman will have jurisdiction over all games played in the tournament. All disputes will be resolved immediately by the Tournament Director / Chairman or as soon as possible thereafter.

**2. ELIGIBILITY OF PLAYERS**

A. Coaches are responsible for insuring the eligibility of their players.

B. Ages of Players

1. **Under 10 - Players must be 9 years** of age or younger as of JULY 31, 2008
2. **Under 11 - Players must be 10 years** of age or younger as of JULY 31, 2008
3. **Under 12 - Players must be 11 years** of age or younger as of JULY 31, 2008
4. **Under 13- Players must be 12 years** of age or younger as of JULY 31, 2008
5. **Under 14 - Players must be 13 years** of age or younger as of JULY 31, 2008

\*C. Players must be registered in an AYSO program as of July 13, 2008.

\*D. Failure to prove eligibility or falsifying eligibility of player(s) will result in the team(s) expulsion from the entire tournament and forfeiture of all games that the team won or tied and that team shall lose by a score of 3 - 0.

\*E. All coaches must carry the AYSO Registration form for each player on the roster at all times.

\*F. All Players must have AYSO identification cards.

\*G. The Tournament Roster must be signed by your Regional Commissioner or his/her agent certifying the eligibility of all players and changes to said Roster. If any team makes changes to its roster, payment "**MUST**" accompany these changes before the changes will be accepted. **Make REGION check payable to "AYSO Region 120" (PERSONAL CHECKS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED).**

\* **A waiver may be granted only by the TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR / CHAIRMAN.**

### **3. FIELDS OF PLAY**

- A. Costa Mesa Region 120 will be responsible for preparing the fields for play.
- B. Each coach is responsible for clean up of the general area after each game.

### **4. TEAMS**

- A. A minimum of seven (7) players shall constitute a team.
- B. The maximum number of players on a team shall be Ten (10), for U-10, (7vs.7) Fifteen (15), for, U-11, U-12, U-13, U-14. . No guest players are allowed. All players must be registered in the AYSO Region from the team that they are playing on.
- C. The HOME TEAM is the first team listed on the schedule and shall change jerseys when there is a color conflict of uniforms.
- D. Teams for all games shall remain on designated side of the field of play. The HOME team has choice of sides.
- E. Only two (2) coaches are allowed on the sideline. They shall remain on their own side of the field and are restricted to the area ten (10) yards from either side of the halfway line. Also, these coaches must be on the Roster Form.
- F. Only players and coaches are allowed on the field. All others must sit in the bleachers, where available, and away from the field of play. Spectators shall remain at least three (3) yards away from the touch lines and away from the area behind the goal lines.
- G. Properly completed game cards shall be presented to the referee prior to the start of the game.
- H. Coaches must check in with their team at the Field Headquarters Registrar a minimum of 45 minutes prior to their first scheduled game time

### **5. UNIFORMS**

- A. Each player on the team shall wear a shirt with a different number and may not exchange it with another player for the duration of that game, goalie shirt excepted.
- B. All uniforms shall be in accordance with \*AYSO National Rules and Regulations.
- C. Shin guards must be worn by all players at all times during the duration of the game.
- D. Sliding Pants/Bicycle Shorts may be worn but at no time can they extend below the knee. The color of the Sliding Pants/Bicycle Shorts must be the same color as the rest of the team and the same color as the dominant color of the regular uniform shorts.
- E. Knee Braces - No hard type, plastic, metal or anything else considered to be dangerous to either the player or opponent may be worn, unless they are properly covered and do not pose a danger to other players, during the duration of the game. Soft wrap only will be allowed but no metal clips can be used to affix it to the player.
- F. No player can play during the duration of the game with any type of hard cast.

## **6. REFEREES AND ASSISTANT REFEREES**

- A. Referees and Assistant Referees shall be assigned by the Tournament Chief Referee.
- B. All games shall be officiated by the diagonal system.
- C. Referees shall at all times impose the Rules and Regulations of competition as defined by AYSO, FIFA Laws of the Game and all tournament rules.
- D. Properly completed and signed game cards must be forwarded by the coach to the Tournament (headquarters tent). (This rule may change, depending which scoring system is being used.)
- E. Referees must file a formal written report for all incidents including injuries, sent offs, and abusive language used by coaches, players or spectators toward them.

## **7. GAMES**

- A. All games will be played on the tournament designated soccer fields.
- B. The referee's acceptance of the game ball is final.
- C. Duration of games - All bracket (pool) games will be two equal halves as listed below **U-14, U-13, U-12, U-11, U-10** two (2) twenty-five (25) minute halves.
- D. \*Games shall be played as scheduled. Only the referee in charge of the game, with the concurrence of the Tournament Director, has the authority to cancel any game. A grace period of five (5) minutes maximum from the scheduled kick-off time will be allowed by the game referee before canceling any game. When games previously in progress are running later than the 5 minutes from scheduled kick-off time, no grace period will be allowed.
- E.. In the event games are postponed because of weather conditions or other unforeseen circumstances, the Tournament Director shall reschedule the games at the earliest possible date and time. If the Tournament is cancelled and not rescheduled, full refunds shall be made, less all expenses incurred against cancelled Tournament, up to the date of the cancellation of said Tournament.

## **8. TOURNAMENT FORMAT**

- A. The tournament is a "round robin" type of tournament. The first place teams in each bracket or pool at the end of the round robin play will advance to the championship game.
- B. For standings in pool play, points will be awarded as follows: 6 points for a win, 3 points for a tie, 0 points for a loss, 1 point for a shut out, 1 point for each goal scored, up to 3 goals, No shut out points will be awarded for a 0-0 tie each team will receive 3 points. (10 points maximum per match for the winning team)
- C. All games will count fully toward determining the winners of each bracket (pool).
- D. If there is a tie in points at the end of the bracket (pool) play, the final bracket (pool) standings will be decided by using the following "tie-breakers" in the order in which they are listed:
  - 1. HEAD-TO-HEAD PLAY (outcome of the game involving the tied teams)
  - 2. GOAL DIFFERENTIAL (goals scored, less goals allowed, with a maximum differential of three (3) per game) Highest differential wins.
  - 3. TEAM WITH LOWEST TOTAL GOALS AGAINST.
- E. There will be no overtimes in bracket (pool) play. Ties will be recorded as such.

## **9. SUBSTITUTION OF PLAYERS**

- A. Substitutions for U-14, U-13, U-12, U-11, U-10, shall be at the half way point of each half (quarters). U-15/U-16 shall be free substitution per AYSO guidelines.

## 10. CHAMPIONSHIP & MEDAL GAMES ENDING IN A TIE AFTER REGULATION TIME

The winner shall be determined by the TAKING OF KICKS FROM THE PENALTY MARK. Only those players ON THE FIELD at the end of the game may take penalty kicks; the goalkeeper may be changed before/after any penalty kick.

## 11. PARTICIPANTS SENT FROM THE FIELD

- A. Any player, coach or spectator who receives a red card (ejection) must immediately leave the game site area. In the event the individual refuses to leave, the referee shall **suspend** the game and contact the Tournament Director.
- B. All players and coaches sent from the field (red carded) must be reported to the Tournament Director (field Headquarters Tent) immediately after the end of the game by the game referee.

The penalty for a player or coach "sent from the field or field area" shall be a **one (1) game suspension** (the following game), **and a loss of 2 points per send off**, unless otherwise specified by the Tournament Disciplinary Committee. **Stronger penalties may be imposed depending on the circumstances as determined by the Tournament Disciplinary Committee.**

## 12. NO PROTESTS WILL BE ALLOWED

## 13. INJURIES

Any injury to a participant, or damage caused by a participant, must be reported to the Tournament Director.

## 14. PLAYER REGISTRATION AND CERTIFICATION

The Regional Commissioner must sign the roster form and in so doing verifies that all players are registered, insured and eligible to participate in this event.

## 15. NO PETS OF ANY SIZE OR SPECIES ALLOWED AT ANY TOURNAMENT VENUES.

Exception: Certified seeing-eye dogs or Certified seeing-eye dogs in training. Certification required.

This is a facility rule and shall be enforced. Please notify all persons involved.

## 16. Refund POLICY.

Full refunds will be given to teams that withdraw prior to **30** days before the tournament. Teams that withdraw less than 30 days before the tournament will receive a full refund **ONLY IF a replacement can be found**. In the event the tournament is completely canceled, a full refund will be issued to all teams entered.

Teams that are not accepted into the tournament will be notified via email and will have their checks returned within 72 hours of being notified that they were not accepted.

Your referee Deposit will be refunded by mail, providing your team's referee team completes its scheduled tournament Assignments.

**ANY SITUATION OR SUBJECT NOT COVERED BY THE AFOREMENTIONED RULES WILL BE DECIDED UPON BY THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR/CHAIRMAN OR HIS DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE(S) AS SOON AS POSSIBLE, AFTER RECEIVING ALL INFORMATION.**

**Team Check-in Procedure**

- Check-in is a minimum of **45** minutes before the team's first **game at the field Headquarters Tent where the team's first game is scheduled to be played**. The coach and full team needs to check in and have all proper paper work complete.
- Coaches must have the game card (line-up) filled out completely in advance.
- If a player did not check-in before the first game but wishes to do so later, he/she can go to field Tournament Headquarters with their coach, AYSO Registration form, and the game card and have their registration verified.
- Only tournament officials can verify the registration of a player.
- Only players who meet eligibility requirements in Paragraph 2 will be allowed to participate in tournament play.

**The following items may be reviewed at check-in.**

- Roster verification, deletions, corrections, etc.
- Game cards ( **Four game cards must be completed prior to check in** )
- Signed registration forms - you must have one for each player on Team Roster.
- AYSO Identification cards are required.**
